The following Expectations have been set for everyone involved in M.A.P.'s 2019 Summer Theatre Workshop. Please read through them and sign at the bottom. It is our goal to make sure that all volunteers and participants have a wonderful experience while learning the discipline and dedication needed to be a part of a full-scale production. Keeping these promises is also important to ensure the safety of all.

- 1. M.A.P. has a solid history of serving our community. To participate in M.A.P. means you are a part of this organization. Please make sure you have completed the membership form. **Annual dues are \$15.00.**
- 2. All participants will treat the Hancock Middle School and PAC facilities with respect and care. Garbage will be disposed of properly and messes in the classrooms and restrooms will not be tolerated.
- 3. All cast members will memorize their lines and songs by the deadlines given.
- 4. M.A.P.'s goal is to provide this workshop experience with no financial impact on the family. However, if you would prefer to purchase your child's costume or make it yourself, please consult with the director and the costumer prior to any purchase.
- 5. All cast members MUST attend all performances.
- 6. We believe in the power of the family! We ask that each family have one member who volunteers to serve the production in some way. This can be supervising backstage, helping build sets, gathering costumes, volunteering at camp, or helping backstage or in the lobby on production days.
- 7. All cast members will attend all rehearsals as scheduled. If you cannot attend a rehearsal, please notify Ms. Bonnie via Facebook as soon as you know of the conflict.
- 8. NO CELL PHONES ON STAGE! EVER! Phones and other electronic devices will be allowed backstage (ONLY) during dress rehearsals and performances, BUT must be on silent. Please do not use phones during camp or rehearsal sessions. You may use them during breaks and before/after camp.
- 9. We ask that each family to sell at least 1 sponsorship or program ad. The more money we get from sponsors and ads, the better our set, costuming, etc. We need your assistance, not only in raising funds, but also in raising awareness of the fantastic things M.A.P. is doing. Ask your local businesses!
- 10. All participants are expected to be on their best behavior. There will be no hitting, cursing, kicking, nor belittling or talking down to anyone by anyone. We will also respect each other's personal spaces. There will be no lap sitting, cuddling or other behaviors that could be seen as inappropriate.
- 11. Please respect the production team, people delegated to be in charge, and other cast members. Please do not give other cast members stage directions during rehearsals
- 12. The use of drugs or alcohol during this production is strictly forbidden by any participant or volunteer. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of either will be immediately dismissed from this production. The safety of this cast will not be compromised by irresponsible behavior.
